

THE ESSENCE OF AIRPOWER: STRATEGIC EFFECT

<u>Characteristics:</u>

- Height (elevation)
- Reach (distance)
- Speed (tempo)
- Precision (long range)



<u>Utility</u>:

- Responsiveness
- Scalability
- Lethality
- Flexibility

THE PROBLEM: CURRENT MILITARY DOCTRINE

The Premise is the Battle:

- invasion and occupation (seize and hold ground)
- battlefield-oriented (engage the enemy)
- ground-centric (armies fight armies)
- war-fighting (combat)

- Damage


