Warfare by delegation through networks of surrogates has become an integral part for how the state is dealing with the challenges of the 21st century – both on the conventional battlefield as well as in the information environment. Based on their book *Surrogate Warfare: The Transformation of War in the 21st Century* (Georgetown University Press, 2019), Andreas Krieg and Jean-Marc Rickli will discuss how in the context of a globalized, privatized, securitized and mediatized geo-strategic environment, states develop new means of statecraft by delegation to achieve their strategic ends.

Andreas Krieg is an Associate Professor at the School of Security Studies at King's College London, Royal College of Defence Studies.

Jean-Marc Rickli is the Head of Global and Emerging Risks at the Geneva Centre for Security Policy (GCSP) in Geneva, Switzerland.
